## **1. Loan Aid: USD 1.69 billion**

## **4. Green Investment Scheme (GIS)**

Provision of 1,568 fuel-efficient Japanese hybrid vehicles for the Patrol Vehicle Renewal Project (under implementation)
Insulation capacity improvement of windows, walls and roofs of schools and hospitals (374 public facilities)
Modernization of ninety-five Kyiv city metro cars with the use of Japanese energy-saving technologies

## **5. Assistance related to Chernobyl and nuclear non-proliferation:**

Chernobyl Shelter Fund USD 98.6 million	Construction of a new safe confinement
