Japan, as a responsible global participant and a G7 member, will actively support Ukraine in stability. In order to support Ukraine's efforts toward stabilization and reforms, it is important to:

- (1) improve the economic situation*
- (2) restore democracy*
- (3) encourage a nation-wide dialogue for national integrity*

Infrastructure project:

Bortnychi Aeration Station modernization project:
USD 1.1 billion (launched June 2015) (loan)

Budgetary support: Development Policy Loan

DPL : **USD 100 million** (July 2014)

DPL-2 : **USD 300 million** (December 2015)

Assistance for purchase of medical equipment:

USD 5 million (March 2015)

USD 3.5 million (July 2014)

USD 1 million for central and eastern regions
(as a follow-up to previous projects)

Project to improve efficiency of coal fired power plants:
exchange of engineers and provision of **new turbines**

Assistance (grant aid) for restoration of infrastructures in eastern regions, provision of **equipment** to medical facilities and **relief supplies** to the NGCA:

USD 13.64 million (January 2016)

Financial contribution to the OSCE Special Monitoring Mission:
EUR 2 million; dispatch of personnel

Assistance (grant aid) for internally displaced people:

USD 22.6 million through international organizations

USD 500 thousand of humanitarian assistance

Assistance (grant aid) for Ukraine's police:

USD 5 million for purchase of 9,000 winter uniform sets (March 2015)
