	Current situation and tasks: Despite the fact that agriculture and food processing are dominant in the industrial structure of Moldova in terms of their contribution to GDP and employment in recent years, the contribution of agriculture use GDP of the country has declined, and other sectors of the industrial structure (second- and third-order) demonstrate growth. On the other hand, although engineering products have substituted the agricultural sector in the Moldovan structure of exports, agricultural products and foodstuffs still remain the largest contribution.
